• Prof. Dr.-Ing Erich Müller-Stiftung: Study scholarships for students of engineering sciences and for the subject areas of physics, computer science or mathematics if there is a direct practical connection to the engineering sciences. Particularly talented, German students from the engineering sciences (especially mechanical engineering, electrical engineering). For computer scientists, physicists, mathematicians, an application only makes sense if there is a very direct practical connection to the engineering sciences. Funding begins at the earliest after the intermediate diploma or after attainment of the Bachelor's degree.

Funding for young university teachers in the field of chemistry; scholarship of € 2,500 per month, duration 3 years (on application, an extension of max. 2 years is possible if the doctorate was completed no longer than 6 years ago at that time); material cost subsidy of € 3,000 per year for the purchase of specialist literature and for attending scientific conferences; prerequisite: doctorate, excellent academic performance, change to another working area ("change of location").

- Prof. Dr. Koepchen Studienstiftung des RWE Konzerns: Support for eligible students of the University of Wuppertal in the field of electricity generation and distribution in the study programmes Electrical Engineering, Information Technology and Mechanical Engineering from the 3rd semester onwards with a grade point average of max. 2.2 in the examinations already taken.

• Berlin / Studentische Darlehnskasse e. V.: Granting of end-of-study loans and doctoral loans for the last 12 months in each case. Funding is only available to students studying at Berlin universities that are affiliated to the loan fund. The maximum amount is 9,000 € or 750 € per month. Repayment begins in the seventh month after disbursement of the last loan instalment. The amount of the repayment rate depends on the loan amount.

• Hessen / Studentische Darlehnskasse Hessen: Students of German nationality at Hessen's universities and art colleges and universities of applied sciences can be granted long-term student loans to complete their studies, so-called graduation loans, (including doctoral studies). The loan is interest-free and amounts to a maximum of €2,301. Repayment is made in 5 equal annual rates. The first repayment is to be made three years after the fixed deadline, but not earlier than one year after the last examination entitling the holder to exercise the profession. A one-time administration fee of 8% is charged, which is retained when the loan is disbursed. A directly enforceable guarantee from a suitable guarantor with a regular income above the garnishment ceiling is required for the conclusion of this loan.
